the support of the priest of our parish. Thank you for your kind support.

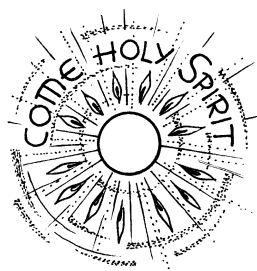
MINISTERS OF THE WORD: The new rota for Ministers of the Word has
