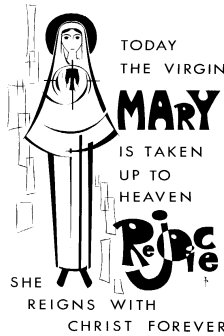


NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME
