Resumption of celebrating Mass with congregations: after 20th July, it is hoped celebrating Mass with a congregation will resume. Before this can happen churches will have to be prepared; this will involve cleaning, mapping out places to sit 2 metres apart (social distancing), provision of hand sanitisation and other considerations. Volunteers to clean and wash the church between celebrations will be needed. If you are willing to assist us, please contact Fr Padraig at the Parochial House. During the summer months the **main church door** will be open during the day for people to pray privately in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament. When visiting the church, please comply with social distancing regulations.



Cemetery Devotions: will not take place this year in June, it is hoped to reschedule these gatherings later in the summer as restrictions are lifted. Please inform family or friends who live outside the parish of these changed arrangements. Renewed thanks to all the volunteers who have been helping keep the cemeteries neat and tidy by cutting the grass. This week the Community Employment Scheme will resume.

Holy Communion for the First Time: We continue to remember the girls and boys from 2nd class in our prayer. We ask parents to continue praying with your children at home, to light your Do This in Memory candle, to collect the parish newsletter, to teach your children the Mass prayers and where possible, tune in to Mass on the parish website athboyparish.ie or on RTE News Now at 10.30am each day.
