Returning to public worship, is a source of great joy and hope, however, public health considerations require changes to the way we celebrate our liturgies.

Under current social distancing restrictions (2 metres apart), there are **60 spaces in Athboy Church** for 60 individuals or 60 couples or households. (Rathcairn only accommodates 20 & Rathmore even fewer)



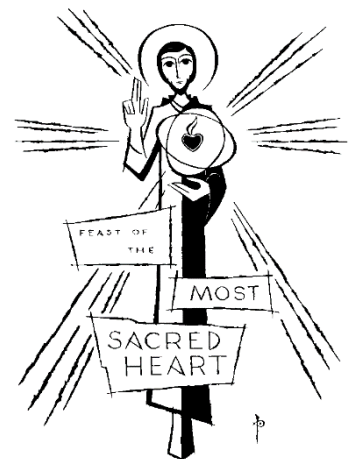
For the time being and because of its larger capacity, Mass will be celebrated in Athboy Church only. A weekday schedule will be announced later.

From 4 & 5th July, weekend Masses for Athboy Parish will be celebrated as follows, 6.15pm Saturday Vigil, Sunday at 9am, 10.15am (as Gaeilge) & 11.30am.

More details of these arrangements will follow in the coming weeks. As restrictions are reviewed, we will return to Masses in Rathcairn and Rathmore in due course.

Dispensation from the Sunday and Holy Day obligation is extended for the time being so parishioners should consider coming to a weekday Mass if attending on Saturday or Sunday proves difficult.

Novena to the Sacred Heart of Jesus: this is the month of the Sacred Heart whose feast day is on next Friday 19th June.
