Returning to Mass: Thank you to all who have offered to help, more volunteers who are not cocooning, are needed to join our COVID-19 Support Team to assist with (a) cleaning and (b) as ushers, supervising entrance and exit from the church. From 29th June, the weekday schedule resumes with Mass at 8am on Monday, 7.30pm Tuesday, 9.30am Wednesday, Thursday & Friday, 10am Saturday.

From 4 & 5th July, weekend Masses in Athboy Church, Saturday Vigil 6.15pm, Sunday at 9am, 10.15am (*as Gaeilge*) & 11.30am.

A ticketing system to ensure capacity is not exceeded is being considered.

Restrictions re social distancing (2 metres apart) means there are approx **60** spaces in Athboy Church to accommodate 60 individuals or 60 couples or households. (Rathcairn can accommodate 20 and Rathmore even fewer)



For the time being and because of its larger capacity, Mass will be celebrated in Athboy Church only. As restrictions are reviewed, we will return to Mass in Rathcairn and Rathmore in due course.

Dispensation from the Sunday and Holy Day obligation remains for the time being, so parishioners should consider coming to a weekday Mass if attending on Saturday or Sunday proves difficult.

Receiving Holy Communion for the First Time: we are happy to begin planning for this important moment in the lives of the children with ceremonies on **Saturday 29th August** in Athboy, Rathcairn & Rathmore. Further details will be available next week.
