Feast of Saints Peter & Paul: Tuesday 29th June, we celebrate the twin founders of the Church in Rome.

Feast of St Oliver Plunkett: Thursday 1st July, born in Loughcrew, ordained priest in Rome in 1654, appointed Archbishop of Armagh in 1669, tried for treason for promoting the Catholic faith in 1679, hung drawn and quartered, the last Catholic to die for the faith at Tyburn on 1st July 1681. He was canonised in Rome in 1975.
