Statue of Our Lady: the newly arrived statue of Our Lady in the sanctuary, was originally in the chapel of Cabinteely House, Co Dublin. When the house was closed and cleared out, the statue was recovered; it spent some years in the nearby gate lodge, later in Co Wexford and it has been kindly donated by the Hamilton family of Woodtown.
