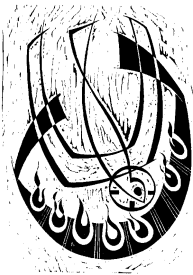

Monday 14th February, St Valentine's Day: Saint Valentine was a clergyman in the Roman Empire, who ministered to persecuted Christians.

He was martyred and his body buried at a Christian cemetery on the Via Flaminia, Rome on 14th February and this date has been observed as his feast day since 496. Some of his relics are held in Whitefriar Street Carmelite Church, Dublin. We pray for engaged couples and for those preparing to get married in our parish this year.
