#### Synod: Everyone is Invited!

A Synod has been called by Pope Francis in order to listen to the living voice of the entire People of God. Everyone has their own experience of following Christ, parents, parents with young families, grandparents, young people who are working, in school or college, those married or single.

Whether you feel distant from or close to what is happening in your parish, you are invited to join in discussion and prayer to discern where the Holy Spirit is leading the Church. This will be happening in every parish in the world. The parishes in Trim Deanery which includes Athboy, Ballivor & Kildalkey, Dunderry, Enfield, Longwood, Moynalvey, Summerhill and Trim, are planning gatherings during March, one will take place in Athboy Church. Further details will follow in the coming weeks.

**Getting Married in 2022:** every couple who intend to marry must complete a Pre-Marriage Course with Accord, give a minimum of three months notice to the parish and to the State Registrar of Marriages of their Intention to Marry, they must also complete the required church paperwork in good time before their wedding.
