

**Feast of St Oliver Plunkett:** Friday 1<sup>st</sup> July. Oliver Plunkett was born at Loughcrew, Oldcastle in 1625. His family were Irish nobility and were supporters of King Charles I. Oliver was ordained



to the priesthood in Rome in 1654 and in 1669 he was appointed Archbishop of Armagh, returning from Rome during difficult times for the Catholic Church in Ireland. He was arrested in Dundalk in 1679 and found guilty of "promoting the Catholic faith" at a trial in London. He was the condemned to a gruesome death, being hanged, drawn and quartered on 1<sup>st</sup> July 1681 at Tyburn. St Oliver was canonised in 1975 by Pope Paul VI.
