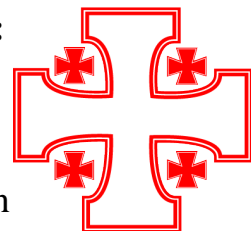

- ✓ Contact and notify the State Registrar of Marriage
- ✓ Complete an Accord Pre-Marriage Course
- ✓ Complete a Pre-Nuptial Enquiry (these are the Church papers including certificates of Baptism, Confirmation and Letters of Freedom)
