FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Sunday 29th January 2023

Wednesday 1st **February:** feast of St Brigid, who was renowned for her hospitality, almsgiving and care of the sick. Brigid was born in 454, despite her father's wishes for her to marry, Brigid insisted on devoting her life to God. She is believed to have been taught by St Mel and received the veil and spiritual direction from him in Ardagh. Other women



followed her example and she founded her monastery in Kildare, her native county. The St Brigid's Cross in legend used by Brigid to explain the Christian faith, remains a sign of God's protection.

Candles to be used in the Church will be blessed at Mass on Thursday morning. If you wish to have candles blessed for use at home, please bring them to Mass on Thursday.

Friday 3rd February: feast of St Blaise. Since the eighth century, St Blaise has been venerated as patron of those who suffer from disease of the throat.
