## THIRTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> October 2023

**Feast of All Saints:** on Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> November the church celebrates the Feast of All Saints, a holyday of obligation. *"The ultimate object of veneration of the Saints is the glory of God and the sanctification of humankind by conforming one's life fully to the divine will and by imitating the virtue of those pre-eminent disciples of the Lord."*

**All Souls:** on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> November the church commemorates all the Faithful Departed. Visits to the graves of loved ones and prayers for their happy repose at this time of the year, remind us that for our loved ones who have died, *"life is changed, not ended."* Our prayer is that they are at peace and with God whose love and mercy are eternal.
